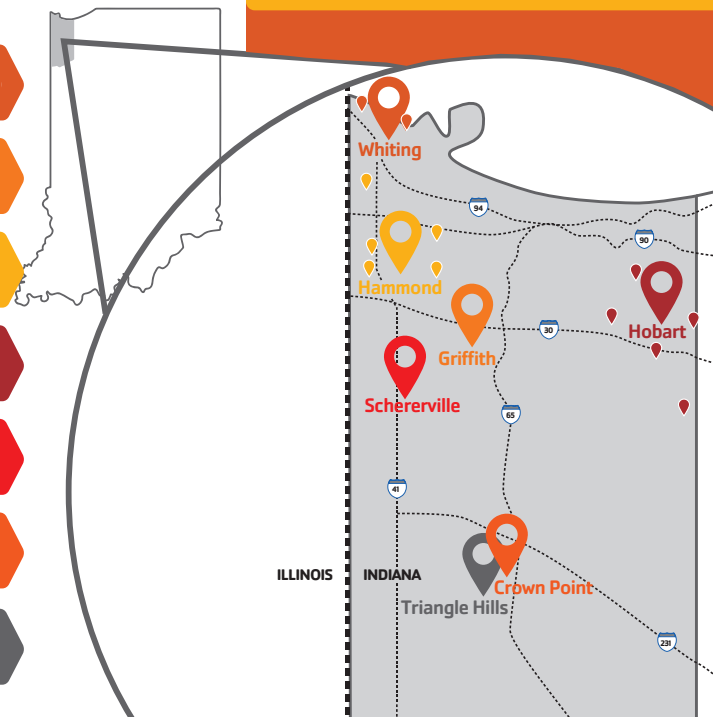

ACCESS FOR ALL

Crossroads YMCA Summer Camp believes every child deserves access to quality care, regardless of financial circumstances. That's why we are thrilled to announce that we have two options to help families afford Camp: 1) Income-Based Assistance and 2) Childcare Development Fund (CCDF), at select branches.



OPTION 1: Thanks to generous donors, the Y offers financial assistance through our Income-Based Assistance Program. Visit crymca.org/findmyrate or scan the QR code below to download the form. You will need to submit with proof of income and a request letter. You can also visit your branch for a form or to get more information. All requests are confidential.

OPTION 2: The CCDF helps families afford childcare so they can work, attend trainings, or continue their education. CCDF vouchers are managed by Indiana's Family and Social Services Administration, not the Y.

Step 1: Complete the online CCDF application found here: <https://earlyedconnect.fssa.in.gov>

Step 2: Provide necessary documentation requested via application.

Step 3: Family and Social Services Administration CCDF committee will review applications confidentially and fairly.

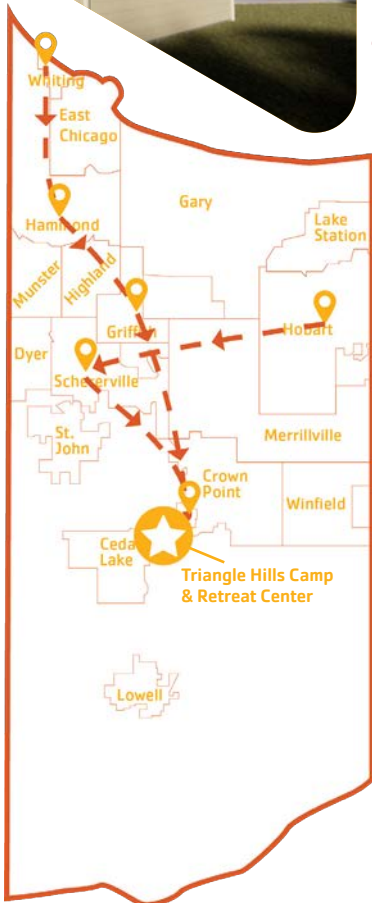

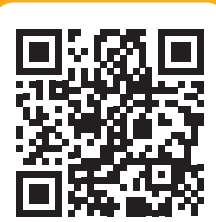
